7. What do the bowls of incense represent? The harps?

#### *Chapter 6*

8. What do the four horsemen represent as a whole? Individually?
9. What do the scales represent? (compare Ezek. 4:16)
10. For what were the souls under the altar crying? What does this symbol say about God?
11. What is the significance of the sun becoming black and the moon like blood?
12. Comparing with Old Testament passages, what is being said in verses 12-17? (Isa. 34:1-5; Hos. 10:8; Joel 2)
13. Why was Israel being punished? (compare Matt. 23-24; 1 Thes. 2:14-16; Heb. 10:28-31)
