- ✳ What do you talk about?

Am I neglecting my Christian duties for the love of material things?

- * **Matthew 6:33** - Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things will be added to you
- * **2 Timothy 4:10** - Demas has forsaken me having loved this present world

Do I derive my security for the future by my things or by my Heavenly Father's care?

- ✱ **Psalm 4:5** - Offer the sacrifices of righteousness and put your trust in the Lord
- ✱ **Do Not Trust In...**
 - ✱ Your job
 - ✱ Your savings
 - ✱ Your house, car, TV, computers, furniture, appliances, clothes, etc.

Am I willing right now to leave all I have materially to go to heaven?

- * **Job 1:21** - Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return there...
- * **1 Timothy 6:7** - We brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.

- ✳ **Matthew 16:25** - What profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?
- ✳ **2 Timothy 1:5** - The faith that was in Timothy started in his mother and grandmother.
